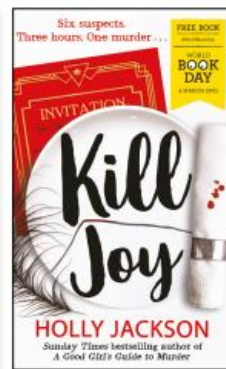
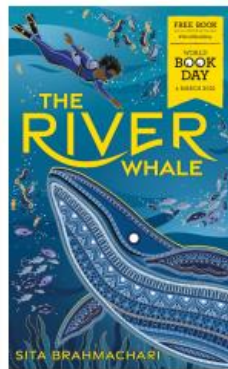
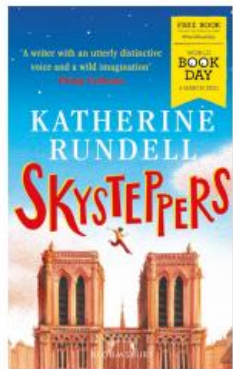
Happy World Book Day!

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



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So, today we'd like you to engage with the world of reading and stay away from screens as much as possible!

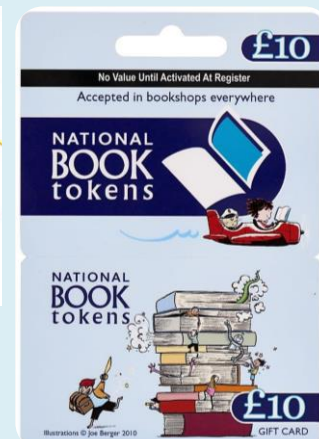



There are lots of brilliant prizes to be won!
