Uniform Update for September 2023

You will be aware that we introduced our new uniform last September, which is currently compulsory for Year 7, with other year groups being given 12 months to transition to it. I am just writing to remind you that the new uniform will be compulsory for all students from September 2023 and a mixture of new and old uniform will not be allowed.







Examples of Appropriate School Shoes

Financially, we know these are difficult times for families so if you need support in buying the new uniform, please do contact Mr Rob Carlyle at newuniformmbs@meole.co.uk . This offer is available to all current Year 8-10 students until September 2023. The new uniform comprises of a white shirt, key stage 3 or key stage 4 tie, blue jumper with school logo for all year groups, 'school grey' trousers or school Meole Brace School skirt. Shoes should be smart, plain black leather (or leather look) with no sports logo evident. Trainers and boots (including Airforce 1) are not permitted.

The only items that have to be bought from our main uniform provider, School Shop Direct (http://www.schoolshopdirect.co.uk/) is the tie, jumper with school logo and the one option skirt - everything else can be bought from other sources should you wish to do so. We are of the opinion that the new uniform is a much better portrayal of what Meole Brace School is all about and we are keen to support families to it being fully in place where needed from September 2023.

Literacy



Verbs ending in -e, like argue, come, pursue, contemplate, often drop the -e before you add an ending (so: arguing, coming, contemplated). The same goes when changing the verb into a noun, like argument.

Changeable

If you're looking at this word and thinking – but you just told me that the -e drops when adding an ending! Then you're right. However, there are exceptions for every rule in the English language. This is one of them. With words like **changeable** the e stays, because it reminds us that it's a soft g sound. Other examples are **manageable** and **salvageable**.
